dēscendō, dēscendere: *to come/go down*

dormiō, dormire: *to sleep*

terreō, terrere: *to frighten, terrify*

vexō, vexare: *to annoy*

videō, videre: *to see*

īnfirmus, īnfirma, īnfirmum: *weak, shaky*

magnus, magna, magnum: *big, great, large, loud*

molestus, molesta, molestum: *annoying, troublesome*

sollicitus, sollicita, sollicitum: *anxious, worried*

Adverbs

fūrtim: *stealthily*

semper: *always*

tum: *at that moment, then*

Pronouns

nihil: *nothing*

tū, tuī, m. & f.: *you (sing.) (tē = acc. sing.)*

igitur: *therefore*
